Your dedicated support allows us to provide uninterrupted, lifesaving care for animals who need us, no matter the challenge or crisis. Our medical fund is the direct link between an animal in need and a chance at life. These are lives that your compassionate gifts have saved.



PANCHO

After a long ordeal, Pancho is recovering and enjoying well-deserved pampering in comfort. He had been suffering for too long upon rescue – having an untreated tail injury that progressed to the severity that his tail horrifically fell off. The remainder of his tail had to be surgically removed.Pancho is healing well, finally having the second chance he desperately needed for a happy, healthy future.

TONY

Tony was left tied to a fence at animal control, a deep wound sliced down his backside, through to the muscle. Following hospitalization and surgery, Tony is a new man, comfortable and loved in foster, recovering on a cushy couch and enjoying the company of his foster sibling. Tony is sweet, friendly, snuggly, good with dogs, and searching for a forever home!

CORI

Not only did Cori survive a traumatic injury in the middle of traffic on the George Washington Bridge, she then overcame a serious reaction to anesthesia during surgery to amputate her shattered leg. Tiny Cori was able overcome all obstacles and is doing incredibly well in her adoptive home. Cori has a wonderful appetite, purrs away and makes the cutest one pawed biscuits!

TOAD

Toad is a victim of breeding trends, an adoptable "microbully" rescued with an open pressure sore, urinary tract infection and an untreated skin condition. He is predisposed to orthopedic conditions from overbreeding and being kept in a cramped space. These days Toad spends his days happily prancing about in his foster home, loving life because he is finally safe and free.



REED

Following a traumatic injury, Reed's tail was painfully broken. It fell off within days, leaving behind an open wound. Upon rescue, Reed was absolutely covered in fleas, flea dirt, grease and grime. At the hospital, most of Reed's remaining tail was amputated, leaving behind an adorable little bobtail. Reed is a shy guy who is making his home in RBARI's cattery enjoying head butts and chin scratches as he waits for a home of his own.

JULIA

Julia was about to be euthanized when we stepped in. This adorable, fragile bunny had been suffering from a broken leg for several days, and the only option to save her life was amputation. Bunnies do well with 3 legs, and we knew that Julia was just as deserving as any animal at a second chance at life!

OPHELIA


Ophelia was rescued off the streets in freezing temperatures. At just 36 pounds, she was malnourished and had recently given birth, her babies taken. A neighbor reported the owner had sold the puppies, moved and abandoned her. In her emaciated state, Ophelia needed immediate rescue to survive the bitter cold. She was treated for dehydration, starvation and parasites, soon being released into a loving foster home to continue her incredible transformation!

PENNY

After being dumped on route 80 with a gunshot / impalement wound, Penny is slowly opening up her heart after suffering so much fear and cruelty in her life. Penny has made an unbelievable recovery. She is happy, sweet and affectionate with her foster family and adores the baby in the home. Though Penny's trust has been shaken, it's remarkable her willingness to open back up to people with just the slightest bit of patience and love.

EDDIE

At just 6-months-old, Eddie was found after days of suffering with a horrific open wound encapsulating her eye. Infection ravaged her injured eye, which could not be saved. Eddie underwent surgery to remove the destroyed tissue and her eye. Despite it all, she is an amazingly sweet and affectionate kitten!



EDAMAME

Edamame suffered pulmonary contusions after a child laid on him, causing crush injuries to his lungs. This tiny Havanese puppy was only 7-weeks-old and 1.5 pounds. Edamame's fragile body fought back. He was able to recover while on oxygen receiving supportive care. Edamame has been adopted and is living his best puppy life!

NOVA


Nova was born with juvenile diabetes. Prior to coming into rescue, she was self-treated with honey and sugar, when she needed insulin. Nova was on the brink of diabetic ketoacidosis upon rescue, requiring hospitalization for a dangerously high blood glucose. With an incredible medical team and foster family, Nova's diabetes is being regulated. She is happy, energetic and all puppy — a completely different dog than the fading puppy who almost lost her life.

NAZZY

Nazzy trailed his rescuer to her car begging for help and food, limping the whole way. He had suffered an attack that left a severe wound requiring surgical intervention. Together with A Pathway to Hope rescue, we provided Nazzy with emergency medical care, a safe haven and time to heal. Nazzy is the most grateful cat, who never stops purring his thanks!

SIMON

Simon is a 13-year-old maltese mix, just 9 pounds, rescued as a severe neglect case. Upon rescue, he was rescued filthy, arthritic, and severely matted, his eyes infected and closed. His teeth were so rotted that they had to be removed when he was neutered. Despite all he has endured, Simon is super sweet and happy. He is feeling SO much better these days, enjoying a new pampered lifestyle!



BRONCO

A tragic accident nearly took Bronco's life. He survived being struck by a car and was able to undergo intricate orthopedic surgery to save his leg by inserting a plate and pins. Bronco is a smart boy who adores playing with his doggy brother, Bandit, and giving kisses to his kitty friends!

DINO

At 12-years-old, Dino slowly starved as his "owner" tossed him scraps. Upon rescue, Dino was emaciated and ill. Dino deserves so much better, and now, through a partnership with Jersey Pits rescue, he has gotten just that. Dino is an amazing soul, sweet and loving with everyone he meets. We aren't sure how much time he has left, but we will make sure Dino's golden years are special.

HOARDING CATS

We united with the local community to assist a cat hoarding case with over 120 cats. Their eyes tell of a life we can't fathom, their environment worse than you can imagine. Through our Community Pets program, we networked with animal control and rescue organizations to intake the cats, provide medical care, and place them with adopters and fosters. Many of the cats at RBARI have medical needs, including neurological concerns, blindness, and scarring on the eyes necessitating enucleation. Over 70 cats have been rescued, as our work continues.

LEO

Leo is an 8-month-old golden, surrendered with a hidden injury. His collar was so tight that it grew into his skin, strangled him and caused esophageal damage. His collar had been removed, hiding the injury, but Leo's medical team discovered the cause of his horrifically swollen neck and inability to hold down food or water. After extensive medical care, Leo is healing and enjoying life as an active, fun-loving puppy. He is searching for his forever home!



HENRY

Henry is a victim of breeding and human greed. Double-merle breeds often have birth defects causing special needs, yet breeders continue to mate them for their coloring and blue eyes – and more money. Though he looks perfect, Henry is deaf and suffered from a heart defect called PDA. He had successful heart surgery, and we are very hopeful that Henry has now been gifted a full life, with thanks to you!

SHAMROCK

At just 10-months-old, Shamrock had endured repeated trauma upon rescue, leaving his body broken. He underwent two days and countless hours of orthopedic surgeries to put his fragile, 6-pound body back together. Shamrock is healing in a loving foster to adopt home. His short life hasn't been easy, but with friends like you, he has found the loving care that changes everything.

ALVIN, SIMON & THEODORE

Alvin, Simon and Theodore were left outside in the cold, discarded by a breeder. Rescued in partnership with Jersey Pits, the pups came to us with severe upper respiratory infections, cleft palates and birth defects. Their care has been a labor of love by their devoted foster mom. Alvin sadly passed away from hydroencephalus, as well as various defects his tiny body just couldn't fight. Simon and Theodore continue to get stronger as they visit specialists to determine the best course of treatment as they age.



Zeus arrived to RBARI shelter with nothing besides a dirty, horribly matted coat. He is a friendly, playful 3-year-old shih tzu mix whose care had been sorely neglected prior to rescue. Zeus was relieved to be free of his dirty, uncomfortable matts. He craves human attention and is looking for his forever home.



MONA LISA

Following a disc injury, it was crucial that Mona Lisa immediately undergo an MRI and surgery to have hope of walking again. With your support, she was able to get this lifesaving surgery. Mona Lisa recovered quickly after surgery and is walking and pottying on her own! She is still slightly wobbly, but her recovery has been amazing!

OLIVIA

With no home and no family to love her, Olivia came to RBARI matted, filthy, frightened, and in pain. Olivia is a 12-year-old shih tzu who suffered neglect, then abandonment. She had an old injury in her eye, causing it to be uncomfortable and blind. Olivia underwent an immediate transformation, including a full grooming and eye removal. Olivia is looking forward to a future of pampered love in her golden years.

CHI PUPPIES

Though adorable, our little chi litter was as a result of neglect and irresponsible breeding. We worked with a local family to help the 15 animals in the home. None of the dogs had been outside the home. They were filthy and clung tightly to rescuers, who promised better days to come. Partnering with Second Chance Adoption League, we were able to transform the lives of 15 animals, and break the breeding cycle.

BUTTERFLY

Butterfly, a 6-month-old poodle, had been suffering from severe vomiting and diarrhea for 4 days prior to being brought to a veterinary hospital, where she was surrendered to us. She was immediately hospitalized on supportive care, including G-tube feeding and fluids. With supportive care, this fading puppy came back to life, brightening more every day until she was released into a loving foster to adopt home!

PATERSON HOARDING CATS: LEMON

Our work continues with the Paterson hoarding case; 120 cats living in deplorable conditions. Through Community Pets, we networked to intake cats, provide medical care, and place them with adopters, fosters and rescues. Lemon is one of those cats, an adult male of just 5 pounds, suffering from illness and parasites, missing toes, and necessitating enucleation surgery due to scarring. These days, Lemon is the happiest little cat who loves to snuggle and gives kisses of thanks for his new life!



MAMA CATS

Our mama cats, Edda, Dottie, Calypso, Sterling, Blossom, Gracie and DOZENS of their babies have come through our doors this year. They inspire us with their selfless and brave instincts to care for their babies as they face the elements, helpless and alone. We are honored to provide our warrior mamas with refuge and a warm place. Their strength in keeping their babies alive despite the odds proves that a mother's devotion to her babies is boundless.

ELEANOR

Eleanor was suffering from pyometria, a severe uterine infection, upon rescue. Without surgery, she would have died. Because of your support of our Community Pets program, we were able to say yes to saving Eleanor. These days, Miss Eleanor is in good spirits, described as a "doll baby" who is incredibly sweet and affectionate. Because of YOU, Eleanor has a second chance at living her best life!

MAX

No medical care was sought for Max when he was hit by a car, shattering his pelvis. By the time he was surrendered to us a month later, it was too late for corrective surgery, and Max was unable to bear weight on one of his back legs. A regiment of intensive rehab, crate rest and pain medication were the only hope to save Max's leg. If his leg impairs his mobility further, amputation would be recommended. Despite his pain, Max has been a gentle boy who is grateful to have found the help he waited so long for.

MILANO

7-year-old Milano was surrendered to us in a neglected state. He was suffering from a perianal hernia and heart murmur, his nails curled under with an unkempt coat. His hernia, a result of not being neutered, was causing him to struggle to go the bathroom. Milano had an echocardiogram, then underwent an intricate surgery to repair his hernia, containing his colon and part of his small intestine. Milano's healing has been a slow process, and he would love to find a home to recover in!



18 PIGGIES

Eighteen guinea pigs were dumped on a farm in Randolph in horrific condition. Left in a tiny, filthy cage, emaciated and covered in bites, they were in such fragile condition that 3 passed away. The surviving 15 piggies are looking great, as they have finally received proper medical care, space to roam and nutrition. This tragic large-scale guinea pig rescue was only possible with your dedicated support, as you show our tiniest of rescues how worthy they are of loving care.

BLUE

Blue is a young cat who suffered repeated life-threatening urinary blockages. All funds had been exhausted by his rescuer when Blue blocked for a third time. With your support, we were able to sponsor his reconstructive surgery (perineal urethrostomy). PU surgery is costly, but extremely successful in preventing the reoccurrence of blockages. Postsurgery, Blue is thriving! He is an incredibly sweet kitty who is so deserving of this chance to live a pain and care-free life.


PUPPY MILL DOGS

Bonnie and Polly spent their lives breeding in a puppy mill. We can't begin to imagine the horrific conditions in which they birthed countless puppies, over 5 years of life. But, with you by our side, we are grateful to be able to rescue Bonnie and Polly from lives as breeding moms in a mill. These mini doodle mamas are friendly and outgoing, seeking attention and enjoying their walks already. Bonnie and Polly are looking forward to their new lives as beloved pets!



BAMBI

After being struck by a car, crippling 3 of her legs, Bambi underwent intensive surgery and procedures to save her legs. She was hospitalized for a week, then released into foster, then hospitalized again for a surgical repair and cultures to ensure her wounds are healing properly. She is still undergoing DAILY bandage changes that allow her legs to heal successfully without infection. It has been a long road, but with your support, we know Bambi will have the promise of a new life.



MARY LOU

Mary Lou was surrendered to us with undisclosed medical ailments, including regurgitation and a heart murmur. She is prone to aspiration pneumonia and requires diligent care to keep her healthy pending veterinary findings. Mary Lou is in the process of undergoing advanced diagnostics to discover the cause of her regurgitation. It has been a trial and error process of medications and feeding methods to minimize episodes. Other than being observant and feeding her upright, Mary Lou is a pretty typical, playful Frenchie.

PABLO

Chronic ear infections and skin allergies have plagued Pablo throughout his life. As a senior Frenchie, it is time for Pablo to finally get the medical care he so desperately needs. Pablo's eye had glaucoma that progressed to the severity of requiring enucleation surgery. After being surrendered to RBARI, he is finally getting relief and medical treatment. Frenchies like Pablo and Mary Lou are prone to long term congenital health conditions. It is an endless cycle due to demand and greed that will only be stopped by choosing to adopt, not shop.

VERA

Vera was discovered outside in Paterson, emaciated, dehydrated and suffering from a severe upper respiratory condition. Her infection was so bad that it caused one eye to abscess, eventually rupturing, and the other eye to be covered in ulcers. At 8-weeks-old, Vera weighed only a pound, her tiny body overwhelmed with parasites. Vera was syringe fed and put on dewormers, antibiotics, and eye medications. She is getting stronger every day as she prepares for enucleation surgery. Despite everything she has been through, Vera is a happy kitten, always purring and making biscuits. Animals need so little to be content, and with your support, we can provide helpless animals like Vera with care they have always deserved!

PHINEAS




PEBBLE

8-month-old Pebble has been through too much in his short life — passed through owners, struck by a car, denied medical care, then taken home to suffer when help had come. He goes to work with her daily and see all his friends who adore him and have cheered for him, every step of the way.



ALBIE

Albie's transformation has been incredible! From a tiny sick kitten slowly fading away, to a playful typical kitten. This is the difference that medical care and a loving home can make for a fragile animal in need. Albie was found in critical condition on the streets, suffering from calici virus, with a severe upper respiratory infection, ulcers in his mouth, conjunctivitis and malnutrition. With medical treatment and a dedicated foster home, Albie is well on his pathway to recovery – next step is a forever home!



After being discovered, sickly and abandoned, Coral and Reef were hospitalized with panleukopenia and calicivirus. With your support, we were able to provide them with intensive, immediate medical care, and they were able to overcome the odds. They are the sweetest little gals who love to play, finally able to be carefree kittens!



ANUBIS

Anubis was an indoor / outdoor cat who was wounded and left without care for weeks. Due to neglect, he developed a severe infection, the flap of skin over the wound completely necrotic. The dead tissue had to be removed and Anubis faced a long, difficult recovery. He won over the affection of his medical team who gave him extra love to make his painful recovery more bearable. Anubis adores his team and is extremely beloved at the hospital.

SCRAPPY

It is heartbreaking when seniors are discarded when they should be so treasured. Scrappy's owner moved and left him with relatives, who promptly gave him up. At 12-years-old, our homeless little chi is starting his life over. Scrappy had rotten teeth, was not neutered and has a grade 3/6 heart murmur prior to receiving medical care through our Senior Fund. He may require a little extra attention in his golden years, but Scrappy still has so much life and love left to give!

PUPPY MILL RESCUE: DOODLES

Over the past 4 months, a team of rescuers have patiently worked with a breeder to save the 16 remaining dogs within her puppy mill. Rescuers were not permitted inside the barn where the dogs lived their entire lives, being farmed and suffering from parasites, rotting teeth, infection, heart murmurs and congenital orthopedic conditions. These are the dads, the abused, the neglected and discarded – the sad reality behind the cute doodle pups being purchased with increasing frequency. Your gifts are providing safe shelter, nutritious meals, lifesaving medical care, an endless supply of love, and FOREVER HOMES as you allow us to do this work – saving lives and breaking the cycle!

PEPPER

At 11-years-old, Pepper suffered from a lifelong skin condition until he found the care he Needed through RBARI's Senior Animal Fund. This adorable, adoptable senior Boston Terrier is feeling SO much better these days. He has received medical treatment nd is healing in a loving foster home. While it is heartbreaking for a senior dog to end up in a shelter, in Pepper's case, his rescue has given him a second chance at his best life.





CC

CC is a 9-year-old shih-tzu who was given away on Facebook, only to end up in an emergency hospital just weeks later, surrendered and in guarded condition. Suffering from a severely infected uterus and mammary masses, CC required emergency surgery, then was diagnosed with aspiration pneumonia. After several days on oxygen, our sweet girl was bright, friendly and eating. CC has healed from surgery and pneumonia and is seeking a home of her own!

ARCHIE

Admitted to the hospital emaciated with an upper respiratory infection, conjunctivitis, maggots, fleas, anemia and parasites, Archie would not have survived without swift, intensive treatment. He was extremely delicate, requiring fluids and heat support to stabilize him. Within days, Archie began to rebuild strength. Today, Archie is in foster care doing well. His appetite is great, and he's putting on weight. Miracle transformations truly are possible – because of YOU! Just ask Archie!



SHEBA

From a discarded, lifeless baby en route to be euthanized to a crazy puppy, Sheba's rescue was only possible with your support! Sheba was discovered unmoving and suffering from parvovirus, but through extraordinary measures and intensive care, she was able to survive, and thrive. With your immediate response, we were able to rescue Sheba before she lost her battle – and now she is a carefree puppy! We thank you for your continued support in helping hurting animals like Sheba find healing and happiness.



SLOAN

Sweet kitten Sloan was found outside febrile and struggling to walk, in extreme pain on his back leg. Doctors found an abscess, which was treated. After crate rest, antibiotics and compresses, Sloan is doing great – walking normally, his swelling resolved and ready to be a silly kitten! Thanks to your devoted friendship, babies like Sloan can find healing all kitten season long!





DREW

Drew was found as a stray kitten, struggling to walk on a heavily swollen hind leg. Her leg was massive from soft tissue inflammation, indicating severe infection. Her wound was cleaned, clipped and cultured, as she began on antibiotics. Drew has healed beautifully and uses both legs now. Her medical team – including her foster mom who is a vet tech – expect a full recovery!

REGGIE

Reggie required 2 blood transfusions for his body to stabilize after being admitted to the hospital with an upper respiratory infection, conjunctivitis, severe flea anemia and parasites. Following intensive care, Reggie was vocal, eating and much more lively. He was discharged from the hospital at 1.5 pounds, and is recovering in a loving foster home. You gave Reggie this chance at life – and through your generosity, he was able to get the lifesaving care and love needed to find healing.

JACK

Jack was helpless and alone, left at the emergency hospital with a horribly fractured leg. RBARI stepped up to take responsibility for this sweet, broken kitten, and since that day, his life has been transformed! Jack underwent two orthopedic surgeries, requiring weeks of physical therapy and crate rest. Your generosity has given Jack the lifesaving care and love he needed to survive and find a family to treasure him. Thanks to you, Jack is loving life because he is finally safe.

PETER PAN

Rescued in shock and horrible pain following a devastating accident, Peter Pan's shattered leg was not repairable due to severe damage sustained. Amputation was the only option to allow him mobility, and our bright eyed, 18-pound ball of joy has adapted well to life on 3 legs. It didn't take long for Peter Pan to steal the hearts of a loving family – and we are pleased to share that he has found a forever home where he is adored!



GEORGIA

When we met Georgia, she was a fading puppy, but today, our pittie princess is a playful baby seeking a home of her own! Georgia was abandoned on the side of the road fighting for her life. With immediate hospitalization, antibody treatment, fluids, a feeding tube, antibiotics, and round the clock care, Georgia shed her tubes and learned what it's like to be a spoiled puppy! Through your dedicated support, Georgia has overcome parvovirus like the tiny warrior she is.



BENJAMIN & DMITRI

This adorable pair was purchased for a child, who inevitably lost interest in them. Benjamin is a long haired Peruvian Guinea pig who requires regular brushing. Due to neglect, this tiny piggie had a matt the size of a baseball upon rescue, affecting his mobility and ability to go to the bathroom. Far too often, small animals like guinea pigs and bunnies are seen more as a novelty than a living, breathing companion animal, requiring caring attention. Since rescue, Benjamin and Dmitri are feeling so much better! While our tiny friends are some of the most vulnerable we have encountered in our rescue work, their spirits remain strong because they have you by their sides.

IZZY

All good news for Izzy – who is healing well and has found a wonderful home! Izzy was rescued in critical condition, requiring emergency foreign body surgery after eating a fabric that perforated her intestines, necessitating the removal of some of her small intestines and tacking of her stomach. With immediate, intensive medical care, surgery and hospitalization, Izzy was saved and has recovered. Izzy wants you to know that today she is feeling treasured, loved and at peace – with thanks to YOU!



When Misty was surrendered, we weren't sure if she was going to have the strength to survive. She was overheating inside a box with wounds on her delicate body, as a result of living outside alone. At just 1-year-old, tiny Misty overcame the odds to survive and find rescue. These days, Misty has been spayed and her wounds have healed. She is filled with curiosity and slowly coming out of her shell. After being horribly neglected, our tiny survivor Misty is ready to start her new life!



STACHE

Stache, a cat in severe pain from a septic elbow, received medical care through the Community Cats program, in collaboration with North Bergen Purr. Despite multiple courses of antibiotics, his condition worsened, leading to the decision to amputate his leg, which successfully alleviated his pain. Now post-surgery, Stache is thriving, enjoying mobility, and ready to find a forever home.

PAGET

Paget was rescued in 2022 and adopted but later returned before being placed in a foster home. After medical consultations for hair loss, her condition is well-managed with daily medication. Now comfortable and thriving, Paget is looking for a forever home, where she can enjoy her curious, food-driven nature and be the center of attention.

FIREFLY

Firefly was rescued at just 0.75 pounds, severely hypothermic and near death, with ruptured eyes and a life-threatening infection. After months of dedicated care and her own fierce determination, she underwent spay and enucleation surgery, completing her healing journey. Now confident, curious, and ready for a forever home, Firefly is eager to find a loving family, using her other senses to navigate the world with a bright spirit.


CASH

Valerie was rescued after being trapped in a car engine, suffering from carbon monoxide poisoning and struggling to breathe. CLAUDE


